



# New "Stroke" Core Measure Order

- Beginning **May 26**, as a stand-alone item or within the Hemorrhagic and Ischemic Stroke Order Sets, are the new Stroke Core Measure tracking orders.
- An active Stroke Core Measure Order will trigger the Core Measure Requirements section within the Discharge Order Set.
- The Core Measures patient list column allows clinicians to easily track stroke patients.
- The Core Measures Stroke Clinical Summary, allows clinicians to track their patient's progress and treatment.
