PICC Nurse Consult Order, Daily Review of Necessity (PICC Line) Flowsheet Documentation, and Remove PICC Line Worklist Manager Task

- ❖ All central line parameter Daily Review of Necessity Flowsheet Documentation has been enhanced to include a drop down of indications i.e. TPN, Chemotherapy, etc.
