



SCM Pharmacy Drip Conversion

To align with the IV drip concentrations present in the Providence Epic system, we will be changing our Hoag IV drip concentrations in phases. This will impact SCM order view, flowsheets, eMAR, as well as the programming on the Alaris pump.

The following adult IV drips will be changed in the first phase, set to go live on **September 21**.

Aminocaproic acid (Amicar)

Argatroban

Cisatracurium (Nimbex)

Diltiazem (Cardizem)

Fenoldopam (Corlopan)

Furosemide (Lasix)

Isoproterenol (Isuprel)

Labetalol (Trandate)

Naloxone (Narcan)

Pantoprazole (Protonix)

Procainamide

Vecuronium (Norcuron)



Additional phases will come with additional IV drips. Please review the order, label from pharmacy, and programming in Alaris carefully. As always, follow the 7 basic rights of medication administration when administering any medication.
